ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Course: All play will be from **WHITE** Tees unless **Green/Blue** Tees are preferred by the player.

Handicaps: Players are encouraged to establish a USGA handicap - \$55 annual fee. Those who do not wish to establish a USGA handicap must provide 3 most recent scores, where an estimated handicap is created but then reduced.

Pairings: Participants may sign up individually or choose one playing companion per week. Pairings will be rotated to avoid the same foursomes playing each week.

EVENT DESCRIPTIONS

April 20 – Warmup – Closest to the Pin Contests

Players will play their own ball. 2 closest to the pin prizes will be awarded on Hole 3 & 9.

April 27 – Opening Day Scramble (Team)

Players will tee off and play from the best spot, continuing this process until the ball is holed.

May 4 - Individual Stableford

Each player will play their own ball the entire hole. Stableford points will be awarded per hole based on the following net score: Bogey – 1pt, Par – 2pts, Birdie – 3pts, Eagle – 4pts

May 11 – Skins Game

Each hole is a possible skin, awarded to the player with the lowest score on the hole of the entire field. The skin pool is divided by the possible skins to determine the pot.

May 18 –Bramble (Team)

Each player will tee off, pick the best drive, then play their own ball into the hole. The best score of the group will be counted as the team score.

Tuesday, May 26 – Pick-Up, Individual Stroke Play

Players will play their own ball into the hole using full course handicap. The best score wins.

June 1 – Best Ball Team Stroke Play (Team)

Players will play their own ball and the best score of the group will then be selected.

June 8 – Least Putts

Players will play their own ball until it is holed and record all putts throughout the round.

June 15 –Blue vs. Gold (Team)

Each player will be assigned to the blue or gold team. The team with the lowest score will win.

June 22 – EVEN Holes

Players will play their own ball and count the even holes as their score.

June 29 – ODD Holes

Players will play their own ball and count the odd holes as their score.

July 6 - Blind Draw Partners (Team)

Each player will play their own ball until the ball is holed, and partners will be drawn at the conclusion of play.

July 13 – Blind Hole

Each player will play their own ball until the ball is holed. Blind holes will be picked at the end of the round.

EVENT DESCRIPTIONS CONTINUED...

July 20 – Throw Out

Players will play their own ball and record the hole-by-hole score. Upon completion of play, players will choose 2 holes to throw out and subtract them from their score.

July 27 – Best Ball Team Stroke Play (Team)

Players will play their own ball and the best score of the group will then be selected.

August 3 – Par 4s

Each player will play their own ball until the ball is holed, & record only Par 4 Holes (2, 4, 5, 6, 7, & 8)

August 10 – Putt For Points

Players will receive points based on the number of putts taken
0 putts=3 pts; 1 putt=2 pts; 2 putts=1 pt., and 3 putts or more=minus 1 pt.

August 17 - Bramble (Team)

Each player will tee off, pick the best drive, then play their own ball into the hole. The best score of the group will be counted as the team score.

August 24 – Green & White Tees

Players will play their own ball into the hole. Holes 1, 3, 5, 7, 9 – Greens & Holes 2, 4, 6, 8 – Whites

August 31 – 4 Club

Players will select any 4 clubs in their bag and play their own ball using only those 4 clubs.

Tues. Sept. 8 – Pick-Up, Individual Stroke Play

Players will play their own ball into the hole using full course handicap. The best score wins.

September 14 – Shoot Your Age

Players will play their own ball. The player closest to shooting their age wins. (Par x2 +HDCP).

September 21 – Blind Draw Partners (Team)

Each player will play their own ball until the ball is holed, and partners will be drawn at the conclusion of play.

September 28 – EVEN Holes

Players will play their own ball and count the even holes as their score.

October 6 – Least Putts

Players will play their own ball until it is holed and record all putts throughout the round.

Tuesday, October 13 – Pick-Up, Individual Stroke Play

Players will play their own ball into the hole using full course handicap. The best score wins.

October 19 – ODD Holes

Players will play their own ball and count the odd holes as their score.

October 26 – Closing Day Scramble (Team)

Players will tee off and play from the best spot, continuing this process until the ball is holed.

If weather permits, the season will be extended for those wishing to participate.
