



STONYBROOK LADIES LEAGUE



Dates: Wednesday, May 3rd - September 13th. **20 week season – play once or every week!**

Times: Tee Times 3:40pm – 4:20pm

Eligibility: Members & Non-members

Format: Players play nine-holes of various individual, and team formats each week to accumulate Player of the Year Points for end of season awards.

Dues: Members - \$80 / Non-Members \$130 (+weekly greens fee) – *Due before 5/3/23*
League dues include official USGA Handicap, end of season banquet, and end of season awards in the form of pro shop credit. Golf cart optional \$10/week. Dues must be paid by the 3rd week of play. *\$30 discount given to players with USGA handicap established at another club.*

Weekly Entry: \$5/week (optional)

Although season points will be awarded for play each week, participants have the option to pay the weekly entry to win golf shop credit based on weekly play.

Signup: Online or phone by the Tuesday before league play on Wednesday.

Players may choose 1 player they wish to play with per week. All other pairings rotated each week.

Players may play as little, or as much as they like with no weekly commitment!

Events rained out or cancelled will not be rescheduled.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Dues: Players participating in 3 or more weeks of play must pay the league dues.

Course: All play will be from **Red Tees** unless otherwise specified
Each week players will alternate between Upper 6 (Par 4) with upper tee on Hole #3, and the following week play Little 6 (Par 3) with lower tee on Hole #3

Handicaps: Players will establish a USGA handicap for 9 Holes - Max 20
If handicap is established at another club, a \$30 discount will be given off dues.

Pairings: Participants may sign up individually or choose one playing companion per week except for "Bring A Friend" Days. All other pairings will be rotated to avoid the same foursomes playing each week. Tee time requests will be honored as close as possible.

Season Long Events:

PLAYERS OF THE YEAR - Awarded to the players who has accumulated the most points over the course of the year through consistency in their play and participation. Champion, Runner-Up, Honorable Mention

1st Place- 10 Points

2nd Place- 5 Points

Participation - 1 Point

BIRDIE CONTEST - Awarded to every player making a gross birdie throughout the season.

PUTTING CHAMPION - Awarded to the winner of the season ending putting contest.

EVENT DESCRIPTIONS

May 3 – Opening Day Scramble (Team)

Players will tee off and play from the best spot, continuing this process until the ball is holed.

May 10 – Skins Game

Each hole is a possible skin, awarded to the player with the lowest score on the hole of the entire field. The skin pool is divided by the possible skins to determine the pot.

May 17 – BINGO, BANGO, BONGO

The first player in the group to get her ball on the green gets a point (BINGO). The player in the group whose ball is closest to the pin once all balls are on the green gets a point (BANGO). The player in the group who is first to hole out gets a point. (BONGO)

May 24 – “Bring a Friend Day” Scramble (Team)

League players may bring a friend for \$17 Greens Fee + \$5 weekly entry. (Cart Fee not included)
Players will tee off and play from the best spot, continuing this process until the ball is holed.
League players without a friend will receive a blind draw.

May 31 – ODD Holes

Players will play their own ball and count the odd holes as their score.

June 7 – Blind Draw - Better Ball of Partners (Team)

Players will play their own ball until it is holed. The best score of the blind partners will be chosen.

June 14 – EVEN Holes

Players will play their own ball and count the even holes as their score.

June 21 –Pick Your Poison

Players will pick 5 holes they think they will score the best on before play

June 28 – “Bring a Friend Day” Bramble (Team)

League players may bring a friend for \$17 Greens Fee + \$5 weekly entry. (Cart Fee not included)
Each player will tee off, pick the best drive, then play their own ball into the hole. The best score of the group will be recorded as the team score. League players without a friend will have a blind draw.
League players without a friend will receive a blind draw.

July 5 – Flag Tournament

Each player will be assigned a number of strokes based on handicap. Once that number of strokes is reached, a flag is placed in the ground. Furthest flag on the course is the winner.

July 12 –Blue vs. Gold (Team)

Each player will be assigned to the blue or gold team. The team with the lowest score will win.

July 19- Stableford

Each player will play their own ball the entire hole. Stableford points will be awarded per hole based on the following net score: Bogey – 1pt, Par – 2pts, Birdie – 3pts, Eagle – 4pts

July 26 – “Bring a Friend Day” One Best of Four (Team)

League players may bring a friend for \$17 Greens Fee + \$5 weekly entry. (Cart Fee not included)
Each player will play her own ball until it is holed and the best score of the team will count.
League players without a friend will receive a blind draw.

August 2 – Throw Out

Players will play their own ball and record the hole-by-hole score. Upon completion of play, players will choose 2 holes to throw out and subtract them from their score.

August 9 – Par 4s

Each player will play her own ball until the ball is holed and record only Par 4 Holes (2, 4, 5, 6, 7, & 8)

August 16 – Putt For Points

Players will receive points based on the amount of putts taken
0 putts=3 pts; 1 putt=2 pts; 2 putts=1 pt., and 3 putts or more=minus 1 pt.

August 23 – “Bring a Friend Day” 3-3-3 (Team)

League players may bring a friend for \$17 Greens Fee + \$5 weekly entry. (Cart Fee not included)
Holes 1-3- Players will tee off and play their own ball and record the best score.
Holes 4-6- Players will tee off and select the best drive, then play their own ball into the hole.
Holes 7-9 - Players will tee off, play from the best spot, continuing this process until the ball is holed.

August 30 – Red & White Tees

Players will play their own ball into the hole using Holes 1, 3, 5, 7, 9 – Reds & Holes 2, 4, 6, 8 - Whites

September 6 – 4 Club

Players will select any 4 clubs in their bag and play their own ball only using only those 4 clubs.

September 13 – Putting Championship Individual & Team with End of Season Banquet

Players will compete in an individual putting contest then choose a partner for the 2nd competition.
The end of season banquet will follow.
