



# WEDNESDAY LADIES 9-HOLER LEAGUE



**Dates:** Wednesday, May 6th - September 16<sup>th</sup>. *20-week season – play once or every week!*

**Times:** Tee Times 3:50 – 4:50pm

**Eligibility:** Open to all Ladies with USGA handicap

**Format:** Players play 9-holes of various individual, and team formats each week for a chance to win Pro Shop credit. Season long prizes will be awarded for consistency in play.

**Dues:** Members - \$120 Non-Members \$175 (+\$26 weekly greens fee) Due *by 1<sup>st</sup> day of play*. League dues include official USGA Handicap, end of season tee gift, banquet, & awards in the form of pro shop credit. \$13 Golf cart optional. *\$25 discount given to players with USGA handicap established at another club.*

**Weekly Entry:** \$5/week (optional)

Although season points will be awarded for play each week, participants have the option to pay the weekly entry to win golf shop credit based on weekly play.

**Signup:** Via Golf Genius email by responding PLAYING or NOT PLAYING. ***Please sign up as an individual for individual events, and players may sign up a team for team events.*** Pro Shop will assign starting times and pairings. Please indicate the earliest starting time you can make, pairings will be adjusted so ladies can play with different players each week.

## ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

**Dues:** Players participating in 3 or more weeks of play must pay the league dues.

**Course:** All plays will be from the **Green Tees** unless players choose to play **Whites**

**Handicaps:** Players will establish a USGA handicap for 9 Holes - Max 20  
If handicap is established at another club, a \$30 discount will be given off dues.

**Pairings:** *Please sign up as an individual for individual events, and players may sign up a team for team events*, Starting times will be no earlier than the player selects but could be later depending on pairings. Meet new friends, build camaraderie and welcome new members by mixing it up!

### **Season Long Events:**

PLAYERS OF THE YEAR - Awarded to the players who have accumulated the most points over the course of the year through consistency in their play and participation. Champion, Runner-Up, Honorable Mention

*1<sup>st</sup> Place- 10 Points*

*2<sup>nd</sup> Place- 5 Points*

*Participation - 1 Point*

PUTTING CHAMPION - Awarded to the winner of the season ending putting contest.

**NEW!** RINGER WALL- Record your best score for the season on each hole!

## EVENT DESCRIPTIONS

### **May 6 – Opening Day Scramble (Team)**

Players will tee off and play from the best spot, continuing this process until the ball is holed.

### **May 13 – Odd or Even Holes (Individual)**

Prior to the round, players will choose to count either the odd holes or even holes. Players will play their own ball, and the winner is the player who is closest to par on their selected holes.

### **May 20 – Pick Your Partner - Better Ball (Team)**

Players will play their own ball until it is holed. The best score of the partners counts as the team score. If players do not have a partner, there will be a blind draw chosen.

### **May 27 – Skins Game (Individual)**

Each player will play her own ball and the best net score wins. For the skins game, each hole is a possible skin, awarded to the player with the lowest score on the hole of the entire field. The skin pool is divided by the possible skins to determine the pot.

### **June 3– 3 Queens and a King Scramble (Team)**

Teams will consist of 2 or 3 queens (ladies), and 1 king (man) invited by the queens. Players will tee off and play from the best spot, continuing this process until the ball is holed.

### **June 10 – Throw Out (Individual)**

Players will play their own ball and record the hole-by-hole score. Upon completion of play, players will choose 2 holes to throw out and subtract them from their score. Closest to Par will win.

### **June 17 – One Best Ball (Team)**

Players will tee off & play their own ball until they are holed and record the best score.

**June 24 – Par 4s (Individual)**

Each player will play her own ball until the ball is holed and record only Par 4 Holes (2, 4, 5, 6, 7, & 8)

**July 1– Flag Tournament (Individual)**

Each player will be assigned a number of strokes based on handicap. Once that number of strokes is reached, a flag is placed in the ground. Furthest flag on the course is the winner.

**July 8 – Pink Ball Scramble (Team)**

Each team (3 or 4 players) has a bright pink ball that rotates among the players. All players will tee off and select the best drive, then one player will play the pink ball into the hole. This process will continue with each player in the group playing the pink ball at least twice for 9 holes. If the pink ball is lost, then the team is out of that tournament. The best net pink ball score wins.

**July 15 –Contest Bonanza (CTP, CTL, LD) (Individual)**

Individual Stroke play with 4 contests. Closest to the Pin on holes #3 & #9, Closest to the line on 2<sup>nd</sup> Fairway, and Longest Drive on hole 1.

**July 22 - Blue vs. Gold (Team)**

Each player will be assigned to the blue or gold team. The team with the lowest score will win.

**July 29 – Low Putts (Individual)**

Players will play their own ball into the hole, and the lowest number of putts win.

**August 5 – 3,3,3 – Best Ball, Bramble, Scramble (Team)**

BEST BALL Holes 1-3- Players will tee off & play their own ball and record the best score.

BRAMBLE Holes 4-6- Players will tee off & select the best drive, then play their own ball into the hole.

SCRAMBLE Holes 7-9 - Players will tee off, play from the best spot, continuing this process until the ball is holed.

**August 12 - Blind Holes (Individual)**

Players will play their own ball and count the blind holes selected by the Pro Shop staff.

**August 19 – – Cha – Cha – Cha (Team)**

Each member of the team (3 or 4 players) plays her ball throughout the round. A 3-hole rotation exists to determine how many scores count. On the 1st hole (Cha), only 1 low score is used, on the 2nd hole (Cha-Cha), the 2 lowest scores are combined, and on the 3rd hole (Cha-Cha-Cha) combine the 3 lowest scores to create the team score. On the 4th hole, the rotation begins again.

**August 26 – Individual Stroke Play (Individual)**

Each Player will play their own ball until it is holed.

**September 2 – Green & White Tees (Individual)**

Players will play their own ball into the hole using Holes 1, 3, 5, 7, 9 – Green & Holes 2, 4, 6, 8 - Whites

**September 9 – 4 Clubs Better Ball (Team)**

Players will pick 4 clubs each and choose a partner. Players will play their own ball until holed. The best score of the partners counts as the team score. If players do not have a partner, there will be a blind draw chosen.

**September 16 – Putting Championship Individual & Team with End of Season Banquet**

Players will compete in an individual putting contest then choose a partner for the 2<sup>nd</sup> competition. The end of season banquet will follow.
